I voluntarily elect or accept and solely assume all risk of damages and injury incurred or suffered by the student named above while attending events organized by the camp. I hereby agree not to sue, and release the camp, its pastors, employees, agents, counselors, volunteer workers, local board, and representatives from any and all liability, claims, damages, and costs for injury, loss, damage to person or property that may occur during the course of my/our child's involvement in events organized by the camp. I further agree that I shall hold harmless and fully indemnify the parties hereby released from any claims, damages, and costs including attorney fees which arise from any claim or cause of action made by me, through me or on my behalf even if caused in whole or in part by any of the parties or entities hereby released. In the event that he/she is injured and requires medical attention, I consent to any reasonable medical treatment as deemed necessary by a licensed health professional. In the event treatment is required from a licensed health professional and/or hospital personnel designated by the camp, I agree to hold such person free and harmless of any claims, demands or suits for damages arising from the giving of such medical care. I also agree to hold harmless and release the camp, its pastors, employees, agents, counselors, volunteer workers, local board, and representatives from any and all liability related to expenses arising from the giving of such medical care to the extent those expenses are not reimbursed by my or the student's health insurances. Further, I affirm that the health insurance information provided above is accurate at this date and will, to the best of my knowledge, still be in force for the student named above at the time of the event specified above. I also agree to bring my child home at my expense should he or she become ill or if a Unstoppable staff member deems it necessary.

I also agree to forgo any money paid for a given event as refunds are only given in case of emergency cancellations (i.e. death in family, illness).

WHAT TO BRING

- Shoes (sandals and closed toed shoes for team comps and open recreation).
- Sleeping bag/blankets and pillow (for overnight campers).

- Bible, notebook and pen.
- “Team Comps Flare” (wigs, costumes, capes, masks, face paint, etc.)
- Water bottle.

GROUND~~s~~ FOR DISMISSAL from Camp

(Any of the following behavior may lead to student dismissal at the expense of the student's family)

- Intentional physical harm to others or to oneself.
- Fighting.
- Any possession of weapons, firearms or fireworks.
- Any possession or consumption of tobacco, alcohol or illegal drugs.
- Theft or destruction of property.
- Being in the dorm of the opposite sex.
- Any sexual activity or nudity.
- Leaving your cabin after curfew.
- Repeated offenses of 'General Rules'.
